Area B Alternate Delegate – Job Description

The Alternate Delegate serves as a valuable assistant to the Area Delegate, often travelling with, or giving reports for the Delegate. If the Area Delegate cannot attend the annual General Service Conference, the elected Alternate Delegate attends in the Delegate's absence. The Alternate Delegate remains on the National Office mailing list as the Area Delegate until National Office is informed otherwise by the Area Committee's Secretary.

The Area B Alternate Delegate is an important, supporting role and needs to be filled. When there is a vacancy in the Alternate Delegate position, Conference and the GSO consider it appropriate for an Area B Committee member to hold the position of Alternate Delegate in addition to their other Committee service position.

Holding the role of Alternate Delegate does not guarantee progression to Delegate. Each Delegate is elected for the qualities they bring to the role and sobriety requirements.

The recommended period of continuous sobriety for the Area B Alternate Delegate is more than two years (preferably more than five years). The Alternate Delegate serves a 2-year term and is a voting office, except when the Alternate Delegate holds another Area B Committee Service position with voting rights.
